Take a closer look at Woodglen Water Treatment Plant

This week there are ideal opportunities to view one of East Gippsland Water's key facilities up close, with public open days being held at the Woodglen Water Treatment Plant near Bairnsdale on Wednesday, 15 and Saturday, 18 January.

This plant was opened three-and-a-half years ago. In conjunction with new water storages, it provides a significant boost to drinking water security and water quality for tens of thousands of East Gippsland residents well into the future.

The facility supplies drinking water to around 24,000 customers along the Mitchell River water supply system, eastwards from Lindenow through to Nowa Nowa. This includes the major centres of Bairnsdale, Paynesville, Metung and Lakes Entrance.

Said Managing Director, Bruce Hammond: "The open days offer a great chance for customers to tour the site and find out more about the processes involved in treating their drinking water, with staff on hand to answer any questions."

There is no need to pre-book, simply turn up on the day and please wear sturdy footwear. Children are more than welcome.
