GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR THE HIRE OF PLANT AND EQUIPMENT FOR GENERAL CONSTRUCTION OR MAINTENANCE TYPE WORKS.

In the event of hire taking place the following conditions will apply.

- 1. The work described, whether verbal or written, is to be carried out to the satisfaction of the Contract Manager.
- 2. The plant supplied shall be in good order and condition, and comply with the conditions set out in Part 3.5 the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations 2007. This may include fitment of a certified Roll Over Protection Structure (ROPS) or Falling Object Protection Structure (FOPS) if applicable.
- 3. The operator shall be competent in the operation of the plant and comply with the conditions set out Parts 3.5 and 6, and Schedule 3 of the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations 2007. The operator must hold the appropriate certificates and accreditations before operating the plant.
- 4. The plant may be inspected for compliance with Part 3.5 of the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations 2007 by a representative of East Gippsland Water.
- 5. Before any work commences the contractor must provide to East Gippsland Water (or representative) evidence of regular inspection, maintenance and repair in accordance with Part 3.5 of the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations 2007. This schedule should be no more than 6 months old and outline the general condition of the plant.
- 6. Before any work commences the contractor must provide to East Gippsland Water a completed risk assessment for the item of plant. Where the contractor performs works in isolation from East Gippsland Water supervision, the contractor must also complete a hazard identification, risk assessment and control form for the works to be undertaken on the form provided at Schedule 1 or other approved format.
- 7. Prior to commencement of work on any day under the period of hire by East Gippsland Water, the operator will inspect the item of plant and a Plant Operators Daily Safety Checklist completed. This checklist will be on the form provided at Schedule 2 or other approved format.
- 8. Hire will only accrue when the machine is operating unless an approved standby arrangement is in place.
- 9. The owner will be responsible for all repairs and maintenance of the equipment whilst it is on hire to East Gippsland Water.
- 10. All servicing, maintenance and repairs are to be undertaken outside the hours for which hire is being paid.
- 11. In the event of hire taking place, the owner will provide WorkCover insurance for employees and employment conditions generally applicable in the industry. Contractors must ensure that any sub contractors comply with the same conditions.
- 12. Owners of plant hired by East Gippsland Water must have in place all necessary insurances ie. public liability, minimum of \$10, 000,000, loss or damage, WorkCover etc.
- 13. East Gippsland Water does not guarantee that any hire will take place as a result of this quotation process.

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
