To Whom it May Concern,

RE: East Gippsland Water Third Party Works Accreditation Process for Design Consultants

East Gippsland Water (EGW) requires accredited Consultants to design water & sewerage infrastructure that interfaces with existing EGW assets. In many cases the new water & sewerage infrastructure, once formally accepted, will become the property of EGW in perpetuity, for the purposes of ongoing operation, maintenance and future renewal. For this reason, EGW has a responsibility to ensure that Consultants designing such infrastructure are appropriately qualified and experienced – including familiarity with relevant EGW specific and industry standards.

If a business wishes to become accredited with EGW, an application in writing must be submitted to Developerworks@egwater.vic.gov.au. This application shall include the attached EGW Form F176 along with relevant supporting documentation. EGW will then assess the application, request any further information if required, and inform the business regarding the outcome of the accreditation application.

Key accreditation criteria include:

- 1) Evidence of accreditation with another Victorian Water Authority or Victorian Government Agency;
- 2) Familiarity with, and acceptance of, relevant EGW and industry standards;
- 3) Evidence of current insurances relevant to the proposed scope of accreditation;
- 4) Evidence of relevant qualifications for all personnel proposed to be involved in the design works, including appropriate supervision of related construction works;
- 5) Evidence of previous experience in the design of equivalent water & sewerage infrastructure;

Construction of new water & sewerage infrastructure is a critical function for EGW. Proper accreditation of Consultants & Contractors is therefore a key requirement for the delivery of high-quality infrastructure for EGW customers.

Consultants are required to enter into a written agreement with EGW for the supervision of related construction works prior to the commencement of construction.

Consultants are required to demonstrate appropriate accreditation for design & other engineering works, including evidence of registration on a national or Victorian register of engineers.

Consultants appearing on EGW's accredited list will be subject to review and required to be provided updated certificates of currency as required. Should EGW become aware of any significant breaches of Occupational, Health and Safety, Environmental legislation or other laws,





or failure to meet baseline quality standards, EGW reserves the right to remove contractors from the accredited list. Should you require any further information concerning the accreditation process, please contact EGW Land Development by email at Developerworks@egwater.vic.gov.au.
