As part of the South Bairnsdale Industrial Precinct upgrades, we have commenced construction on the \$550K South Bairnsdale Booster Pump Station project.

The pre-cast concrete tilt panel building was erected recently and fit out including installation of pumps, electrics and controls, and associated civil works will be completed over the coming weeks. We anticipate commissioning will occur towards the end of October.

The project is being undertaken in conjunction with East Gippsland Shire Council to improve water pressure and flows in the South Bairnsdale Industrial Precinct.
